A. COLLEGE AVENUE SIDEWALKS: Discussion of cost items related to sidewalk improvements on College Avenue:

- a. **Underground Utility Placement:** SWEPCO has provided cost proposals for installing electrical lines underground, to eliminate overhead electric lines at all locations between Maple Street and College Avenue. Costs and further detail are provided for each location.
- b. **Signal Pole Replacement:** Existing signal poles at Maple Street and North Street will be replaced as necessary. Poles at intersections to the south, through the downtown area, are decorative, fluted poles that are approximately double the cost (based on cost dated from the previous project), or approximately an additional \$25,000 to \$30,000 at each location. As an alternative, standard poles could be powdercoated (painted) for less than \$10,000 per location. The type of treatment would also be used at the proposed location of the additional signal near Rebecca street.

(Staff requests a recommendation from the Committee to the Administration for these items).

B. VAN ASCHE DRIVE/HWY 112 SIGNAL: Presentation of bids for signalization at Van Asche Drive and Highway 112. **(Staff requests a recommendation from the Committee to the City Council for this item)**

C. VAN ASCHE DRIVE AND HIGHWAY 265 (CROSSOVER ROAD) TREE INSTALLATION: Presentation of bids for installation of trees in the medians of Van Asche Drive, and Highway 265 (Crossover Road) from Joyce Street to the City limits. **(Staff requests a recommendation to the City Council for this item.)**

D. OLD WIRE ROAD/MISSION BLVD INTERSECTION SIGNALIZATION: The AHTD has received bids for the Old Wire Road and Mission Blvd intersection project, and has requested a check for the City's share of the project. **(Staff requests a recommendation to the City Council for this item.)**
