I am running on the principles of a conservative-based and fiscally responsible platform. I would like to see a more prosperous Fayetteville for all citizens."

Baucom and Terminella have the utmost respect and regard for the Members of the Fayetteville Chamber of Commerce and hope to continue earning their support during this process. Both candidates believe face-to-face interaction with citizens is more effective than the low-attended recent City Council candidate forums.

"I would rather get out and go to the people to understand their needs and concerns," Terminella said
