SUBJECT: CH2M Safety Award Recognition

On January 17, 2017, the Arkansas Department of Labor and Arkansas Workers' Compensation Commission recognized the CH2M Fayetteville team with the 10-year Accumulative Years Safety Award. To achieve this milestone, the CH2M staff accumulated 10 years without a lost day away from work due to a work-related injury or illness between September 21, 2006 and September 21, 2016.

CH2M's adopted culture is achieved when their employees value the Health, Safety & Environment program and take responsibility for their own behavior and for the behavior of every employee around them. When an incident does occur, they seek continual improvement by evaluating the causes, implementing corrective actions, and learning from their mistakes.
