RE: FAYETTEVILLE POLICE MAKE ARREST IN HOMICIDE

Fayetteville Police Chief Greg Tabor announced today the arrest of CHRISTOPHER RANKIN, black male, age 25, for Murder in the 1st Degree.

On January 1st, 2018, at approximately 12:47AM, a patrol officer was flagged down and advised of a disturbance in the parking lot of 548 W Dickson St. Upon arrival officers found **TRENTON CONEY**, black male, age 22, with a gunshot wound to the chest. Officers immediately rendered first aid and provided care until medical personnel arrived on scene. **CONEY** was transported to a local hospital where he succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased.

Through the investigation, and via several witness statements, it was learned that RANKIN was speaking with a female subject in the parking lot, when CONEY walked up to check on the female. This upset RANKIN, who then pulled a gun from his jacket pocket and pointed it at CONEY. After exchanging a few words, RANKIN put the gun back in his

pocket, and a physical altercation ensued between RANKIN and CONEY.

During this altercation CONEY fell to the ground, at which time RANKIN

stood over him, pulled the gun from his pocket, and fired one shot striking

CONEY in the chest. RANKIN fled the scene before officer's arrived, but was located in Fayetteville a short time after the incident. RANKIN was taken into custody without incident and charged with Murder 1st Degree.

This investigation is still on-going.
