SUBJECT: Purchase of one Excavator and Attachment for Water & Sewer

RECOMMENDATION:

City Council authorize the purchase of a Dodge Ram 1500 4WD Quad Cab from Lewis Automotive Group of Fayetteville, AR in the amount of \$22,572.00, pursuant to the Arkansas State Contract, for use by the Water and Sewer Department.

BACKGROUND:

Unit 2143 is a 2011 Chevrolet Silverado 1500 4x4 Extended Cab with only 11.6/15 points. However, it has exceeded the 6 year life expectancy and is now having engine trouble. The amount to repair this is not cost effective considering the age and remaining life of the unit.

DISCUSSION:

Fleet recommends the purchase of a Dodge Ram 1500 4WD Quad Cab from Lewis Automotive Group of Fayetteville, AR in the amount of \$22,572.00, pursuant to the Arkansas State Contract, for use by the Water and Sewer Department.
