A RESOLUTION TO EXPRESS THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE TO WORK JOINTLY AND COOPERATIVELY WITH THE FAYETTEVILLE PUBLIC SCHOOL BOARD TO INCREASE OPPORTUNITIES FOR ACTIVE RECREATION FOR FAYETTEVILLE RESIDENTS

**WHEREAS**, access to active recreation is the Fayetteville citizens' highest priority as identified in the Imagine Tomorrow's Parks surveys; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fayetteville Public School District operates numerous high-quality active recreation facilities throughout Fayetteville; and

**WHEREAS**, expanded access to active recreation facilities is associated with improved public health outcomes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, ARKANSAS:**

Section 1: That the City Council of the City of Fayetteville, Arkansas hereby expresses its intention to work closely and in unison with the Fayetteville Public School Board to expand access to active recreation facilities for its citizens.

Section 2: That the City Council of the City of Fayetteville, Arkansas hereby authorizes the City Attorney and Mayor to develop an appropriate shared use agreement for expanded facility access.

Section 3: That the City Council of the City of Fayetteville, Arkansas hereby expresses its intention to increase in-kind or monetary compensation including additional budgetary authority to facilitate our citizens' improved access to active recreation facilities.
