**1. Old Business:**

- A. MASTER STREET PLAN UPDATE:** Review of the draft Master Street Plan update. The Master Street Plan is proposed to be updated as part of the City's Comprehensive Plan update (Cityplan 2040), in accordance with the recommendations of the Fayetteville Mobility Plan. Draft master street plan map and cross sections attached. **(Staff requests a recommendation from the Committee to the City Council on this item)**
- B. TRANSPORTATION BOND PROGRAM:** Review of project list proposed for the first phase of the bond program. The total proposed amount of the first bond issue for transportation is \$36 million; this includes construction funding in the amount of \$32 million, design projects in the amount of \$1.8 million, and a contingency amount of \$2.16 million. List and map of recommended phase 1 projects is attached.

**2. New Business:**

- A. ZION ROAD IMPROVEMENTS:** Review of a proposed concept for Zion Road, between Vantage Drive and Crossover Road, and review of a proposed contract in the total amount of \$165,110 with McClelland Consulting Engineers for design revisions to the project plans. Design revisions will include changing the cross section per the attached concept, review and possible redesign of the roundabout at Old Missouri Road, additional water and sewer design, and associated surveying services. **(Staff requests a recommendation from the Committee to the City Council on this item)**
- B. RUPPLE ROAD IMPROVEMENTS:** Review of a proposed contract with Crafton, Tull, and Associates in the amount of \$110,400 for surveying and street/water line design services on Rurple Road, between the east and west legs of Weir Road. Regrading and improving Rurple Road in this area is necessary to connect the existing road with the new extension of Rurple Road to the south that is being constructed as part of a development cost share. **(Staff requests a recommendation from the Committee to the City Council on this item)**
- C. LAFAYETTE STREET BIKE LANE STRIPING:** Review of a proposed striping plan for bicycle facilities along Lafayette Street, between West Avenue and College Avenue. This segment of street will be repaved this summer; the attached striping plan is proposed to be implemented after the paving is complete. **(Staff requests a recommendation from the Committee to the Administration on this item)**
