A. MAPLE STREET CYCLETRACK: Review of revised plans and request for approval to apply for grant funding for construction. **(Staff requests a recommendation from the Committee to the City Council on this item)**

B. WEDINGTON CORRIDOR SAFETY, WALKABILITY, AND TRANSIT: Discussion regarding the existing and proposed Wedington Corridor related to walkability and transit access. Presentation by Staff and Razorback Transit.

C. TRANSIT SHELTERS: Review of preliminary priority lists for transit shelter installation. Staff has performed a preliminary review of more than 150 Ozark Regional Transit and Razorback Transit stop locations for placement of shelters and other amenities. Staff evaluated each stop location based on average number of boardings, the need for easements or right-of-way acquisition, existing amenities, and the amount of site work necessary for construction. After review of the locations and referencing the recommendations from the Fayetteville Mobility Plan and the University of Arkansas Transportation Plan, a list of the 26 most suitable and construction-ready locations was compiled.

Staff has also researched options and pricing for commercially produced shelter and seating products for committee feedback.

D. RUPPLE ROAD BIDS FOR CONSTRUCTION: Review of bids for construction of Ruple Road, between Weir Road east and Weir Road west of Ruple. **(Staff requests a recommendation from the Committee to the City Council on this item)**

E. TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) GRANT: Review of a request to apply for federal-aid funds and allow staff to submit an application of an 80% federal 20% local matching grant through the Arkansas Department of Transportation - Transportation Alternatives Program for an award of up to \$500,000 and City match of \$125,000 to be used for the Clabber Creek Trail tunnel under Garland Ave. (Hwy 112) at Van Asche Drive. Funding for the match has been budgeted through the 2019 Bond for Trail Improvements.

F. RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM (RTP) GRANT: Review of a request to apply for federal-aid funds and allow staff to submit an application of an 80% federal 20% local matching grant through the Arkansas Department of Transportation – Recreational Trails Program for an award of up to \$428,000 and City match of \$107,000 to be used for the reconstruction and improvement to the section of the Lake Fayetteville shared-use paved trail across the dam. Funding for the match has been budgeted through CIP trail development program.
