#### 1. Old Business:

A. MIDTOWN CORRIDOR: The midtown corridor consists of improvements to Porter Road and Deane, Sycamore, and Poplar Streets, and a neighborhood bikeway connection from Poplar to Gregory Park on Sycamore Street. A design charrette was held on March 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>; a summary of the charette process and results is attached. A staff memo providing answers to Committee questions at the April meeting is attached as well. (Staff requests a recommendation from the Committee to the Administration on this item)

# 2. New Business:

- A. MINIMUM STREET STANDARDS UPDATE: The Minimum Street Standards document is a supplement to the Unified Development Code, and establishes criteria for design and construction of street, sidewalk, and trail infrastructure in the City. The focus of this update is to align the MSS with the new Master Street Plan, but other revisions have been made to reflect current best practices and new design guidance, and to correct/clarify sections as necessary. Revisions to multiple code chapters are also proposed, again mostly to align with the new Master Street Plan. A summary of the proposed changes is provided in the attached memo.
- B. ARCHIBALD YELL SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS: Review of a proposed contract with Garver Engineers for design of improvements to Archibald Yell Blvd. This item is on the June 2, 2020 City Council agenda. (Staff requests a recommendation from the Committee to the City Council on this item)
- C.
