Special Needs Assistance Program Renewal Grants

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the grant renewal award amounts and approval for the Mayor's authority to sign the renewal agreements when received.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Fayetteville Hearth Program has been in operation since February of 2016, and to date we have housed 95 adults and 106 children. This program is funded by three annual grants. Grant AR0043 will expire on May 31, 2020 and grants AR0039 and AR0044 will expire on August 31, 2020. Renewal grant funding will begin on June 1, 2020 and September 1, 2020, respectively.

DISCUSSION:

The renewal grants are SNAPs Grant AR0039L6F011906 in the amount of \$32,117, SNAPs Grant AR0043L6F011905 in the amount of \$171,426, and SNAPs Grant AR0044L6F011905, in the amount of \$35,222.
