- 1. Do you remember our first tutor trainer, Jamil Mohad Shami? Find and take a picture of his name on the senior walk at U of A. (Reminder/Hint: He began studying around 1964).
- 2. We are proudly supported by the Barbara Broyles Endowment which was set up and celebrated in 2004. Find and take a picture outside of the bank the celebration was held in. You may have to investigate our social media feeds to find the answer.
- 3. Find and take a picture with one of our old buildings/sites. Document how the buildings/sites changed and what occupies them now. We have had locations at: 3703 N. College, No. 6, 1774 N College Ave, and 3042-B Market Ave
- 4. We participated in many NALA meetings held at this popular Fayetteville destination known for its fabulous views. Go up there and take a picture capturing this beautiful site.
- 5. Look through our scrapbook series and recreate one of our #OLChistory moments! Be sure to let us know which pic you are recreating. We have some fun ones!!
- 6. Did you know we made a cookbook a couple of years ago featuring food from our students' homelands? Make a delicious non-American dish or meal (be sure to include a recipe so others can enjoy it later too). Share the meal (and recipe) on Instagram for bonus points. - 7. Create a music video for our song (debuted on May 5<sup>th</sup>) or a cover of it. (Do both for double points).
- 8. Once a month, we take our students on a field trip to Crystal Bridges. We haven't been able to do that since the quarantine began, but there are still activities to do to stay connected to art. - 11. We are missing the tower of books at Fayetteville Public Library. Create your own tower of books and show it to us!
- 12. Did you know a late, local mystery author wrote a murder mystery book set at a literacy council based on OLC? Find the book and take a picture of the cover (which looks remarkably familiar...). [digital covers work if you cannot find a physical copy!]
- 13. Every Sunday we share a book quote that resonates with us that week. Create your own graphic with a book quote that you love (Students: feel free to use a quote in your native language bonus points if you translate it into English for us!). Let us know who the author is and from which book your quote is from.
- 14. Take a picture of one of our friendly neighborhood pig-sibition statues (Bonus points for featuring the least photographed pig in the scavenger hunt).
- 15. Give this a chance and take a picture of our multilingual landmark.
- 16. We are provided a steamy, caffeinated beverage by one of our supporters. This beverage helps perk up students and teachers alike during morning classes. Snap a picture outside one of our donor's locations (a bonus point for each of their cups in the picture up to 5).
- 17. It may not be the great white way, but just like the wicked witch of the west, our partners know how to put on great shows! Take a picture in front of one of their buildings!
- 18. Get out in nature, take a picture of one of your favorite spots on our wonderful trail system. If you don't have a favorite spot, take a picture of something interesting you see on the trail!
- 19. Expand your knowledge at this essential Fayetteville institution. Capture the expanse from the mountain outside this fantastic site of resources!
- 20. What do you think of when you think of Ozark Literacy Council? Print out our logo and take a picture of it with something or someplace in Fayetteville that reminds you of OLC. You will receive a copy of the logo when you sign up!
