- A. CITY WIDE SPEED LIMITS IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS: Review of a recommendation from the Active Transportation Advisory Committee for reduction in speed limits in residential areas. The ATAC voted unanimously to recommend to the Transportation Committee that they consider exploring the option of lowering the prima facie (default) speed limit in residential areas to 20mph, and how that would affect current safety, enforcement, development, and other related issues in residential areas.

RAILROAD CROSSING AGREEMENT AT SHILOH DRIVE/GREGG AVENUE: Review of a proposed contract with Arkansas and Missouri Railroad for installation of a new railroad crossing at Shiloh Drive and Gregg Avenue. - C. RAILROAD CROSSING AGREEMENT AT FUTRALL DRIVE/GREGG AVENUE:
