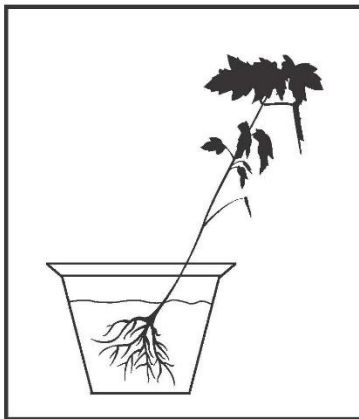


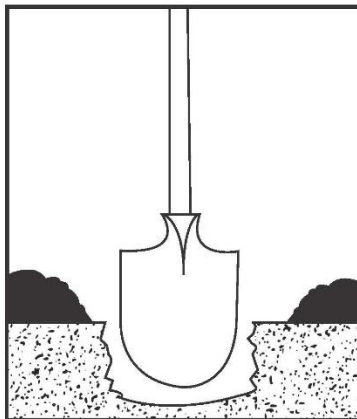
How To Plant Your Bare Root Tree



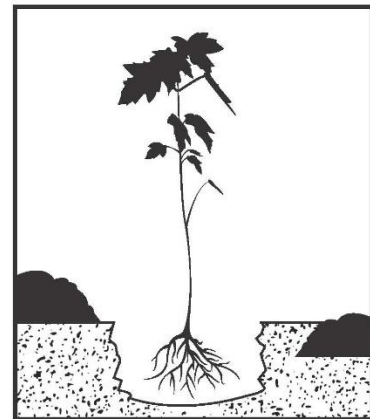

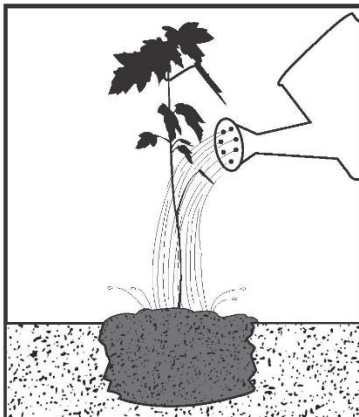
Keep roots moist and plant as soon as possible. Soak roots in water for 3-6 hours before planting.



Dig a wide hole no deeper than the tree roots.



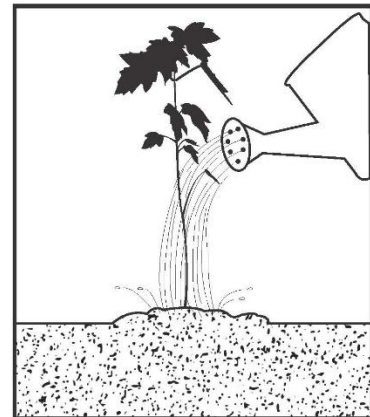
Plant so only roots are below ground. Planting too deep will kill trees.



Refill hole with same soil that was removed and water generously. Do not use potting soil or fertilizer.



Mulch plant area. Don't let mulch touch stem.



Water regularly for the first two years, if possible.
