### RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends a brief time to recognize civilians who have demonstrated life-saving heroic service at a Motor Vehicle Accident Scene.

## **BACKGROUND:**

On March 14, 2022, Fire Department Apparatus L3, E5 and B1 responded to a Motor Vehicle Accident (MVA) with a vehicle flipped upside down and fully involved in fire. After our arrival, we were notified that two bystanders had reached in, cut the seatbelt and removed the driver of the burning vehicle. These civilian actions deserve to be recognized for their courage and going above and beyond. These two gentlemen put their lives in danger to save the life of a stranger. Had it not been for their actions, the passenger may have not survived.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The Fayetteville Fire Department is proud of the efforts of citizen Wes Wooten and citizen Griffin Webb for demonstrating heroic life-saving service at a motor vehicle accident on March 14, 2022. Their actions on this scene reflect the purpose of our department to protect life, property, and the environment with Honor, Courage, and Commitment.
