

Council Member D'Andre Jones plans to present the attached amendment to add Section 2 to delay the effective date of the renaming resolution until Juneteenth, 2023. Attached is his proposed Amended Resolution.

WHEREAS, the Black Heritage Preservation Commission has requested that rename Archibald Yell Boulevard to Nelson Hackett Boulevard to honor Mr. enslaved person in Fayetteville in 1841 took a horse with saddle, a gold watch and fled to Canada, but was apprehended there on a charge of theft; and	
WHEREAS, abolitionists struggled to prevent Nelson Hackett's extradition to failed, and Mr. Hackett was returned to slavery in 1842, publicly whipped and slavers; and	o Fayetteville, but I sold to Texas
