SUBJECT: Robert Walsh - Water Damage Claim at 2416 E. Sharon St.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of a payment in the amount of \$10,434.25 to Robert Walsh for a water damage claim arising at 2416 E. Sharon St., and approval of a budget adjustment.

BACKGROUND:

On March 17, 2023, the meter was turned on by the Meter Department and continued to run. The meter reader shut the meter off but the cut off malfunctioned, allowing water to continue through the meter, which flooded the home. The Water & Sewer department replaced the faulty cut off.

DISCUSSION:

The total damages were in the amount of \$10,434.25 and included flooring, sheetrock, and painting. The breakdown of expenses is below:

- \$5,434.25 - Home Depot for material and flooring
- \$4,600.00 - Stuture Homes for remodeling work
- \$400.00 - Robert's Jill of all Trades - Painting

Staff recommends Robert Walsh be reimbursed in the amount of \$10,434.25 to cover the expenses related to the water damage claim.

BUDGET/STAFF IMPACT:

A budget adjustment is attached to move funds into the Self Insurance - Non-Vehicle Damage account.
