MEETING July 19, 2023 MINUTES

A meeting of the Fourth Judicial District Drug Task Force Control Board was held on July 19, 2023.

Captain Brad Renfro called the meeting to order. Upon roll call, the above-listed members were acknowledged as present. Copies of the minutes from June 28, 2023, meeting were distributed to all present. A motion was made by Chief Jay Cantrell and seconded by Chief Frank Gamble to approve the minutes. The motion was approved unanimously.

A copy of the financial report for the Grant FY2022-2023 was distributed to all present for review, the period ending May 31, 2023. Willie Newman stated the total expense to date was \$585,504.00 which included Federal 235041-21AJ \$ 21,087.00, Federal 235041-22JL \$62,232, State 235041-22JL \$43,597.00, State J23-004-DF \$91,319.00, Local 235041-22JL \$18,670.00, Local J23-004-DF \$27,396.00, and Non-Allowed-\$313,203.00.

Sergeant Jacob Lawson reported on the task force's activity from June 1, 2023, through June 30, 2023, and he distributed a copy of statistics to all present. Lawson stated that in June the task force opened 16 cases, closed 16 cases, and made 4 arrests. Lawson further noted that \$800.00 was expended for the purchase of evidence and \$700.00 for the purchase of information. Lawson stated that drugs seized during the month included: methamphetamine, marijuana, cocaine, crack cocaine, MDMA, fentanyl, and pharmaceuticals. Lawson stated that 0 warrants were served. Also noted, were 4 drug convictions for June. The task force seized \$763.00 U.S. currency during the month. The locations of DTF Enforcement Action for the month were Fayetteville 12 cases, and Springdale 4 cases.
