SUBJECT: Seven Hills Homeless Center Funding Agreement

RECOMMENDATION:

A Resolution to waive competitive bidding, to approve a monthly funding agreement with Seven Hills Homeless Center contingent on satisfactory contractual performance for the period of January 1, 2024, through December 31, 2024.

BACKGROUND:

The Seven Hills Homeless Center has provided services to homeless and needy residents in Fayetteville for over 20 years. Seven Hills is a not-for-profit organization that has relied almost exclusively on private donations for operational funding during that period.

The City Council approved the 2024 budget which appropriated funding for the 2024 fiscal year to maintain the operations of the day center by Seven Hills in the amount of \$119,400. Although funding for the center by generous donors has improved, a shortfall still exists.

The contractual amount would be paid in monthly disbursements of \$9,950 each month beginning in January 2024. Attached is a contract for services with Seven Hills
