Fleet Re-Fueling Island Canopy Replacement

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A BUDGET ADJUSTMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$49,341.00 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT OF THE FLEET FUEL CANOPY AT THE HAPPY HOLLOW COMPLEX

WHEREAS, on April 23, 2022 a Recycling and Trash Collections driver damaged the fleet fuel canopy at the Happy Hollow Complex rendering the canopy unsafe necessitating its removal; and

WHEREAS, the Fleet Division is moving forward with an upgrade to the Happy Hollow Complex electronic fuel tracking, inventory and processing system and the canopy needs to be reinstalled to safeguard this new equipment; and

WHEREAS, the canopy will also provide employees with protection from the elements while refueling their equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: That the City Council of the City of Fayetteville, Arkansas hereby approves a budget adjustment in the amount of \$49,341.00, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution, for the construction, repair and replacement of the Fleet Fuel Canopy at the Happy Hollow Complex.

RECOMMENDATION:
