#### Bid 24-30 D.J. Shubeck Company – Biosolids Sludge Pump

A RESOLUTION TO AWARD BID # 24-30 AND AUTHORIZE A CONTRACT WITH D.J. SCHUBECK COMPANY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$56,340.36 PLUS ANY APPLICABLE TAXES AND FREIGHT CHARGES FOR THE PURCHASE OF A BIOSOLIDS SLUDGE PUMP FOR USE AT THE WEST SIDE WATER RESOURCE RECOVERY FACILITY

# BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, ARKANSAS:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the City Council of the City of Fayetteville, Arkansas hereby awards Bid No. 24-30 and authorizes Mayor Jordan to sign a contract with D.J. Schubeck Company in the amount of \$56,340.36 plus any applicable taxes and freight charges for the purchase of a biosolids sludge pump for use at the West Side Water Resource Recovery Facility.

SUBJECT: Bid 24-30 D.J. Shubeck Company – Biosolids Sludge Pump

#### RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends awarding Bid 24-30 and authorizing the purchase of a biosolids sludge pump from National Oilwell Varco L.P. c/o D.J. Schubeck Company in the amount of \$56,340.36 plus applicable taxes and freight charges for use at the West Side Water Resource Recovery Facility.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The existing biosolids sludge pump at West Side WRRF failed in late 2023. It is 1 of 4 sludge pumps in the process, and it was original plant equipment from 2007. The cost of a rebuild on this pump is approximately 80% of the cost of purchasing a new pump.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The City of Fayetteville solicited formal bids for a new biosolids sludge pump per Bid 24-30. National Oilwell Varco L.P. c/o D.J. Schubeck Company was the lowest qualified bidder in the amount of \$56,340.36. D.J. Shubeck is the manufacturer representative, and National Oilwell Varco is the pump manufacturer. The purchase would be made from National Oilwell Varco so that the City gets better pricing.

Staff recommends awarding Bid 24-30 and authorizing the purchase of a biosolids sludge pump from National Oilwell Varco in the amount of \$56,340.36 plus any applicable taxes and freight charges. This will bring all four sludge pumps back into operation at the West Side treatment facility.

#### **BUDGET/STAFF IMPACT:**

Funds are available in the Plant Pumps and Equipment account within the Water & Sewer fund.
