NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, ARKANSAS:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the City Council of the City of Fayetteville, Arkansas hereby states their unqualified support for an immediate and permanent ceasefire, for life-saving humanitarian aid for Gaza, and for the release of all hostages and political prisoners.

<u>Section 2</u>: That the City Council of the City of Fayetteville, Arkansas hereby condemns all anti-Palestinian, Islamophobic, antisemitic, xenophobic, and hateful speech directed against any person or group.
